The Queenborough Society has a watching brief for activities in the Queenborough area. We monitor planning applications where appropriate, and try to encourage development in Queenborough.

We support Queenborough in bloom by cleaning the memorial prior to judging.

We receive regular reports from the Museum and the Harbour.

This year has been a fairly quiet one for the Society, although the museum and harbour have both been very busy: a new film has been made by the museum and further developments implemented in the harbour.

The Abbott's cup was awarded to the Philippa bed & breakfast hotel for their development of the old public house, transforming it into a very useful addition to local amenities.

We are monitoring developments at Peel Ports as there is no longer a functioning Sheerness Society.

Yellow lines will be implemented at the North Road / Stanley Road junction, which the society supported.

We still have a problem with the Queenborough Charity. Hopefully this will be resolved eventually as, although there is not a large amount of money involved, it is sufficient to provide charitable help to Queenborough school children.
